Book & Bake Sale: Given by Nanci

- We still have some open positions
- Tables ordered should be there Tuesday, will set up on Wednesday and will start unpacking books
- Thursday is complete unpacking of books and a lot of people are signed up
- We don't have someone to put out signs in people's yard in certain locations, and signs 2
 weeks before the sale in town (Jodi will help)
- We need someone to pick up food for Wednesday volunteers
- Anyone who wants to volunteer please tell Nanci!
- Bake sale waiting for people to station at the bake sale
- We have A LOT of books!
- Book dealers are near holding area and they will be monitored

Treasurer's Report: Given by Susan.

- \$10,000 in memberships added thanks Michelle!
- \$77,000 in 3 accounts
- \$14 service charge with new bank we are limited to 200 combined transactions a month –
 they count each check as a transaction we had 228 transactions and this wont happen most
 months. Spoke with bank and waiting to hear back to see if we can get fee waived since we
 are non-profit
- E-mails that we send out we use a service provider called mail chimp they are changing their policy (we were on a free plan) but now you can only have 500 contacts or they will charge you \$27/month (total 15,000 contacts). Each time you send an e-mail in a month it counts e.g., 500 contacts, 3 e-mails that month = 1500 "contacts". We don't have a good way of being able to tell if they are old e-mails or not. We will keep it for March and April and we will think about something else after book sale.

Trustee's Report: Given by Ken.

- Next meeting Thursday, March 16th at 6:30 in the library unsure of location but assume usual meeting space in school house
- Status of library building discussed
- All patron fines have now been forgiven
- Still issue fines for stuffbrary and museum passes
- Sarah mentioned programs going on
- Library open house for June 17th or June 24th kick off to summer reading program and will feature indoor mini golf, touch a truck, games
- '24 budget submitted, includes increase of over 3%
- Policies up for review in March safety and security and tutoring policy
